Spirit of Love Scholarship Overview

Rebekah Leah Rivera was a member of Mary Immaculate Catholic Church who died on June 20, 2004. She attended Mary Immaculate Catholic School and graduated from Ursuline Academy of Dallas in 2001. She also had strong ties with the Jesuit Community. Rebekah lived a life of loving service to her church and community. For this reason, her friends and family wish to keep her memory alive by awarding scholarships to young people who live their lives with that same spirit.

<u>Qualifications for the Diocesan Wide Spirit of Love College/University Scholarship OR High School</u> <u>Scholarship</u>

- 1) For the College/University Scholarship:
 - o Be a graduating high school senior in May 2026 and
 - o Be a registered parishioner in the Roman Catholic Diocese of Dallas and
 - o Provide proof of volunteer community service throughout the last 4 years.
- 2) For the High School Scholarship:
 - o Be a graduating eighth grader in May 2026 and
 - o Be a registered parishioner in the Roman Catholic Diocese of Dallas and
 - o Provide proof of volunteer community service throughout the last 2 years.

Only one scholarship application will be considered per applicant. If criteria for multiple scholarships are met, the applicant must select which scholarship to apply for and submit <u>one</u> application along with required materials as detailed in the Application Checklist.

How to Apply

To apply for a Diocesan Wide Spirit of Love Scholarship, please complete and submit the attached application, as well as the following:

- Complete volunteer community service information on attached form
- Parish registration verification letter on Church letterhead signed by the parish pastor or secretary
- At least one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, priest, youth minister, club, or organization sponsor
- ❖ An official school transcript
- ❖ A recent non-copyrighted photo of yourself
- Provide a written essay (500 words or less, double-spaced) on this topic:

Using the verse from Romans 8:28, "And we know all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose." How have you seen God work during a challenging time in your life? During this time, were you aware how you and God worked together towards a positive solution? Explain. How has this challenge strengthened your faith in God to be able to help someone else going through a difficult time in their life?

Please complete the attached **Application Checklist.** For your application to be considered complete, the checklist <u>MUST BE INCLUDED</u> with your application packet. <u>INCOMPLETE OR LATE APPLICATION PACKETS WILL</u> <u>NOT BE CONSIDERED</u>.
